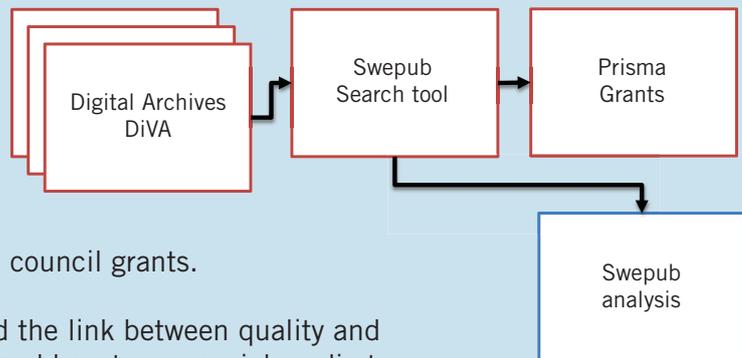


SUPPORT FOR RESEARCHERS

Publishing/Diva

Regarding Publication Infrastructure, there are several parts in the publishing chain that we at the library can help with. You can for instance get guidance on how to submit to our digital repository DiVA, and registering for ORCID, an researcher ID needed e.g. to apply for Swedish research council grants.



It might also be relevant to better understand the link between quality and visibility, how the publishing process works, and how to use social media to gain visibility for your research. We can also help you with how to use tools like Ulrichsweb, SHERPA/RoMEO, Web of Science, Scopus to evaluate possible publication channels. We cooperate around these issues with the University Archives, and the Grants and Innovation Office.

Open Access/Open Data

We would love to help you with questions regarding Open Access and Open Data, such as why and how. At the present, we together with the University archive are developing a structure to archive and/or publish research data.

Search Support

We are working on improving the possibility to provide information seeking support. We are also working on streamlining the documentation of search results to make it as clear as possible for you.

Interlibrary loans and purchases

In order to make all needed information/literature available to our researchers, we have a patron driven acquisition. Knowing how this works is important for you to manage your information searching; don't give up, if you find something we don't have, order it! Bibliometrics

When it comes to bibliometrics we can help you by looking up bibliometric indicators in order to support you in your research context. Bibliometrics can also be useful to place journals and publications in context within your discipline and publishing tradition. We can also give you tips on how to search and interpret bibliometric indicators.

Reference Management

We can also help you with questions on reference management and using reference management tools like EndNote. Reference management tools are a great help when collaborating with other researchers and our Search support.
